Enjoy a week of exploring art and animals with Julie and Bethany Brown!

Campers will spend time each day with Bethany, learning about the animals at Wabi Brook Farm – horses, sheep, Patches the goat, Truffles the pot-bellied pig, 3 different breeds of dogs, cats, and the wild animals we often see. Find out how to care for them, their habits, how they think and act, how they move, how they are built, and so on!

You will also spend time each day with Julie, learning how to draw and paint the animals, using what you learn about them to help you! We will also learn how to draw the buildings on the farm, the trees and flowers, and even the machinery if you wish. No previous drawing or painting experience is required. This is your chance to explore, and to be creative, no matter if you are a beginner, or more experienced.

This is not a riding camp as such, but you will have one riding lesson during the week with Bethany. Please bring your own helmet and riding boots. If you do not have your own helmet, you may borrow one of ours. Boots must have a smooth sole and a half-inch block heel.
